We are grateful for the inputs that we received from the esteemed jury members that were used to further improve the Duare Sarkar portal, leading to improved service delivery and ultimately benefitting the common citizens of the state.

BPO Policy - To create approximately 30,000 jobs in Odisha by 2022 in this sector. Through this Policy, Government endeavors to build a strong foundation in the State for the BPO industry and attract entrepreneurs to invest and set up centers in the State. Thus, Information Technology is playing a pivotal role for assisting Government in providing citizen centric services.
