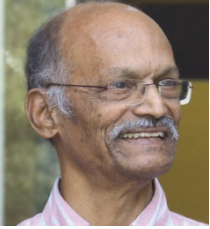

Having been involved as a Reviewer for these awards for some years now, I have been witness to the diversity of project nominations from across the country over the years. What is particularly encouraging is that there are many nominated projects which have drawn upon similar implementations and learnings from other parts of the country and are adapting the projects to their own state's needs. This is a healthy trend which will lead to the speedier progress of e-governance implementations across the country.

I found field Visits are a very useful element of the evaluation process as it enables the nominee to present parts of the project which are difficult to encapsulate in the nomination application. It also enables a reviewer like me to assess the level of involvement of various stakeholders and gain a deeper understanding of the project. Some project nominations are driven by the IT implementation agencies and not so much by the concerned government user departments themselves ... this results in the nominations becoming more technology focused. As against this those nominations driven by user departments brings in service delivery focus and related operational challenges

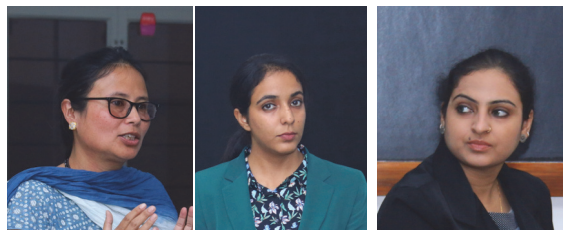
